Export of munitions fabricated from the depleted uranium is authorized only to members of NATO, Japan, Australia and New Zealand. 3. The depleted uranium will be used for non-nuclear use only.

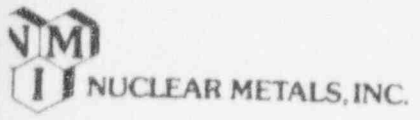
