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OPERATING PROCEDURES

- 1. Revise the Operating Procedures to specify that the package is loaded and closed in accordance with written procedures.
- Revise Section 7.1 of the application to include verification that the package is proper for the contents and that the package is in unimpaired physical condition.
- 3. It appears that several steps were inadvertently omitted from the Operating Procedures (see numbering of steps 7.1.1 through 7.1.3). Revise the Operating Procedures to include the following: proper closure of the primary containment vessel (including bolt torque), leak testing of the primary containment vessel, loading and proper closure of the secondary containment vessel.
- Revise the Operating Procedures to include the application of a tamperindicating device and the labels required by DOT regulations.
- 5. Revise Sections 7.4.2.2.3 and 7.4.2.2.4 to clarify the term "sample shield." Note that the terminology should be consistent with the packaging drawings.

ACCEPTANCE TESTS AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

- Revise Section 8.1 of the application to include the following tests or determinations prior to first use of each packaging:
 - a. Verification that the packaging is free of cracks, pinholes, or defects which would reduce the effectiveness of the package.
 - Verification that the packaging is marked in accordance with 10 CFR §71.85(c).
 - c. Verification that the packaging was fabricated in accordance with the drawings referenced in the Certificate of Compliance.
- Revise Section 8.2 of the application to specify any tests or inspections which are performed to ensure that the foam has not retained moisture, has not deteriorated, and remains properly sealed.
