Haddam Neck Plant NUREG-0737 Item II.E.1.2; Automatic Initiation of Auxiliary Feedwater

Gentlemen:

The referenced letter presented a descripton of the automatic auxiliary feedwater feature at the Haddam Neck Plant and described the circumstances under which this feature could be bypassed and the alarms available to inform the operators of the bypass condition. This letter is in response to a verbal request by the Staff for additional information concerning the alarm function.

The referenced letter states:

"When the mode switch is moved to the non-automatic position, the operator is alerted by an audible alarm and a continuously lit annunciator."

The operator, upon acknowledging the annunciation, will silence the audible alarm however the annunciator window will remain lit. This annunciator will remain lit reguardless of power level or plant mode of operation until the handswitch is returned to the automatic position. Only at this time will annunciator window darken.

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We trust that this clarification resolves the concern.
