SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF CONFIRMATORY ACTION LETTER

On March 1, 1993, Sequoyah Unit 2 was manually tripped from full power. The Unit was tripped when operators noticed an increase in main generator voltage. Subsequent to the trip, a steam leak was discovered in an extraction steam line to a feedwater heater. The leak was caused by erosion of the piping. Unit 2 was immediately taken to Mode 3 after the trip. Based on the unknown condition of the Unit 1 extraction steam piping, licensee plant management directed that Unit 1 be shut down for inspection.

On March 4, 1993, the NRC issued a Confirmatory Action Letter, documenting the actions to be taken by TVA before the restart of either Sequoyah unit.

By letter dated October 5, 1993, TVA confirmed the completion of these actions in support of the restart of Unit 2. Additionally, by letter dated April 7, 1994, TVA confirmed the completion of actions in support of the restart of Unit 1.

NRC inspections of corrective actions have led to the conclusion that the actions specified in the CAL have been completed. The NRC documented our


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concurrence with the restart of Unit 2 by letter dated October 21, 1993, and concurred with the restart of Unit 1 by letter dated April 14, 1994. Accordingly, this letter documents the closure of CAL No. 2-93-003.

As stated in my letter to you dated April 11, 1994 (in response to your comments on our SALP report) we expect your staff to implement long term corrective actions described in the Sequoyah Site Improvement Plan. We intend to examine the effectiveness of these actions and meet with you periodically to discuss your progress.
