
During a telephone conversation between you and Linda Robinson on July 13, 1982, you agreed to accept a nonproprietary version of the proposal.

A copy of the requested record is being made available in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555, for public inspection and copying. The records will be filed in folder FOIA-82-306 under your name. You may obtain access to these records by either presenting a copy of this letter at the PDR or requesting folder FOIA-82-306.

There is no charge for inspecting records at the PDR. The charge for copying records maintained in the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a).

If you do not wish to visit the PDR to inspect or copy these records, you may obtain copies by calling (634-3273) or writing directly to the PDR to request copies. Upon your agreement to pay the copying charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be copied by a private contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by the private contractor for the copying charges, plus tax and postage.
