

The Commission delegated to the EDO (10 CFR 1.31(c)) the authority to develop and promulgate rules as defined in the APA (5 U.S.C. 511(4)) subject to the limitations in NRC Management Directive 9.17, Organization and Functions, Office of the Executive Director for Operations, paragraphs 0213, 038, 039, and 310.

The enclosed final rule entitled "NRC Operations Center Commercial Telephone Number and Facsimile Number Change" will amend 10 CFR Parts 20, 21, 30, 35, 40, 50, 70, 72 and 73. This final rule will change the NRC Operations Center telephone number from (301) 951-0550 to (301) 816-5100 and the facsimile number from (301) 492-8187 to (301) 816-5151.

This final rule does not constitute a significant question of policy, nor does it amend regulations contained in 10 CFR Parts 7, 8, or 9 Subpart C concerning matters of policy. I, therefore, find that this rule is within the scope of my rulemaking authority and am proceeding to issue it.
