Gentlemen:

SUBJECT: Application for Amendment of Operating License and Request for a One-Time Schedular Exemption from 10 CFR 50.36a(2)

Enclosed please find Omaha Public Power District's (OPPD) "Application for Amendment of Operating License" which seeks to amend the Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The changes requested reflect the new 10 CFR Part 20 and supplements the application transmitted in References 2 and 3.

Attachment A contains a markup reflecting the requested changes of the Technical Specifications. Attachment B provides the "Discussion, Justification and No Significant Hazards Consideration." To assist in your review all pages, including those not revised from References 2 and 3, are included in the attachments. OPPD respectfully requests 30 days from the date of issuance to implement these proposed changes.

With the issuance of the proposed amendment, OPPD also requests a schedular exemption from 10 CFR 50.36a(2). Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 50.36a, subsection (2) requires, in part, that a report be submitted to the Commission annually that specifies the quantity of each radionuclide released to unrestricted areas in liquid and gaseous effluents during the previous 12 months of operation. It further requires that the time between submission of the reports must be no longer than 12 months. OPPD requests a one-time exemption from the requirement of 10 CFR 50.36a(2) that the time between submission of the reports be no longer than 12 months.

Technical Specifications (TS) 5.9.4.a implements the reporting requirements of 10 CFR 50.36a(2). The proposed change to TS 5.9.4.a will require that the report be submitted to the Commission prior to May 1 of each year, consistent with the draft Generic Letter prepared by the NRC for implementation of the new 10 CFR 20 requirements. The previous requirement for submission of this report was within 60 days after January 1 of each year (March 1). Therefore approval of the proposed change will require a one-time schedular exemption in order to change

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the date of submission from March 1 to May 1. The exemption will not affect the information required to be submitted or the time period the report covers (previous year's data), only the date the report is to be submitted. After the one-time exemption the submittal date will correspond to the proposed TS change of May 1 of each year.
