26. Since PP&L's dose assessment system involves the projection of future doses as well as the ascertainment of prior doses, the means exist to advise emergency workers long before their doses would reach the 15-20 rem range.

27. Therefore, notwithstanding the absence of TLD's and CDV-730's for the interim period, adequate dosimetry exists to protect the health and safety of emergency workers.
