ADDENDUM TO

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS IN VAN BUREN AND PARTS OF BERRIEN AND ALLEGAN COUNTIES

- On page 2, under "For Further Information," James R Collis is now the Deputy Director of Emergency Preparedness for Berrien County.
- On page 5, under "Local Alert," paragraph three, the sirens are now tested on the second Saturday of every month. Cross out the word "first" and insert "second" in its place.
- On page 7. under "What is In Place Protection?," add "If you must go outside to warn a friend or family member, limit your exposure. You might be advised to cover your mouth with a cloth."
- On page 8, under "What If I Am Instructed To Evacuate?," disregard the second sentence of paragraph three ("Put on a dust mask or breathe through a damp handkerchief to filter out any dust in the air.") You should cross out this sentence, as this respiratory protection should not be needed and could hinder your movement.
- On page 11, under "How Would I Be Informed?," the last sentence should read – "A regular test of the siren and public address system is done the second Saturday of each month at 12:00 noon." Cross out the word "first" and insert "second" in its place.
- On page 22, under "maximum permissible dose," line four should read "...500 millirem of radiation per year." Cross out the word "day" and insert "year" in its place.
