SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, unannounced inspection was conducted in the areas of Physical Security Program for Power Reactors, specifically; Access Control of Personnel and Vehicles; Alarm Stations and Communications; Assessment; and Security Training and Qualification.

Results:

In the areas inspected, a violation was identified. One violation of regulatory requirements relating to misissue of security badges was confirmed. In addition, an inspector followup item was established to track the licensee's efforts to improve the assessment capabilities for the protected area perimeter. Review and observation of routine security operational activities confirmed that the security force was performing at an acceptable level. However, the continuing degradation in security systems and equipment, all of which is programmed for replacement as part of the security upgrade, was demonstrated by the unexplained failure of the printing function of the security computer system on April 27, 1994.

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
