

Dear Sir:

In reply to Mr. Pollack's letter dated July 25,1968, I agree to act as your Radiological Safety Officer under the terms stated in the attached letter.

As your Radiological Safety Officer, I feel that it is necessary that I be informed of all purchases and shipments of radioactive material. It would also be prudent if I spend a minimum of four hours each month at the Waltham facility inspecting and reviewing operating procedures.

In reference to the government contract for 16,000 compasses which you are presently negotiating, I wish to point out a very restrictive and unrealistic test requirement specified in MIL-C-006235B (DM), section 4.6.9-Radiation Level which states," Evidence of the radiation level in excess of background radiation shall constitute failure of this test."

Commercially available Promethium- 147 has trace amounts of a contaminent. Oak Ridge laboratories, one of the major suppliers of Promethium-147 reports the contaminent as Americium-241. This nuclide has a 60 kev gamma which most certainly will give a contact radiation reading in excess of background. In fact, I measured a sample compass supplied by 3M and in the possession of Mr. Marcell and found the radiation levels at the crystal faceto be in excess of 2 milliroentgens per hour.

I suggest that the above requirements be modified and be consistant with A.E.C. regulations Title 10 Part 30.15 which states "The levels of radiation from hands and dials containing Promethium-147 will not exceed, when measured through 50 mgs per square centimeter of absorber, 0.1 millirads per hour at 10 centimeters from any surface".
