STAFF REQUIREMENTS - BRIEFING ON MINIMUM NUMBER OF SHIFTS REQUIRED AT OPERATING REACTORS, 2:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY, JULY 21, 1982, COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM (OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission* was briefed by staff on alternatives in specifying a minimum number of shifts at operating nuclear power plants.

The Commission by a vote of 3-1 voted against taking any steps to develop a policy or a rule on the number of shifts. (Chairman Palladino and Commissioners Ahearne and Roberts voted against; Commissioner Gilinsky voted in favor.)

The Commission directed that inspections of operating reactors include examination of a sampling of overtime records to determine the cause for the overtime, whether work is properly authorized in accordance with existing procedures and whether the authority for overtime is being abused.
