I read Christopher Arellano's article "UNC [United Nuclear Corporation, Montville, Connecticut] says it spent millions to clean its abandoned site" that appeared in *The Day* (New London, Connecticut) newspaper on Friday, March 18, 1994.

I am interested in technical information on that site. Please send me copies of any memoranda, reports or other information relative to assessment and cleanup of toxic chemicals in air, soil, and water at the site that could be relevant to transfer of the property if it is purchased by the Mohegan Indian Tribe of Connecticut, Inc. for use as a casino-resort. Standards and criteria for acceptable concentrations of contaminants would be particularly helpful.

I would like a copy of the letter terminating the NRC manufacturing license and supporting documentation.

As background for my site review, I would also appreciate a copy of any relevant regulations, guidance documents, evaluation criteria, etc. that could be used in evaluation of potential human health or environmental risk at the site.
