Gentlemen:

This letter constitutes an interim report concerning the potentially reportable condition reported under 10CFR50.55(e) on December 8, 1982. Henry J. Kaiser is in the process of reviewing all QA documentation and is identifying deficient inspection personnel whose qualifications and certifications may not have been appropriately documented.

To date approximately 40% of the related inspections have been reviewed. About forty-five percent of the concerns identified from the related documentation review completed have been satisfactorily resolved.

Due to the number of documents that have not yet been reviewed, and the need to correlate any inspector documentation deficiencies with installed hardware conditions, no specific potentially reportable hardware deficiency has been identified. This review is continuing. A follow-up report will be issued by May 8, 1983 to provide an updated status and determination of any identified deficiencies.

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
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We trust the above will be found acceptable as an interim response under 10CFR50.55(e).
