NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Refinery Products Corporation

License No. 48-03665-02

As a result of the inspection conducted on March 1, 1983, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 20.401(b) requires that you maintain records showing the results of monitoring required by 10 CFR 20.205(b) and (c), "Procedures for picking up, receiving, and opening packages."

Contrary to this requirement, you failed to maintain records of the monitoring you performed on February 15, 1982 and May 18, 1982, of incoming packages containing more than a type A quantity of iridium-192.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement IV).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
