Haddam Neck Plant Emergency Preparedness Exercise

Reference (1) suggested that emergency preparedness exercise scenarios be submitted to both the Staff and FEMA in accordance with the schedule provided in Reference (2). Therefore, Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO), on behalf of the Haddam Neck Plant, is hereby submitting ten (10) copies of the draft Exercise Controller's Manual for the upcoming April 23, 1983, Haddam Neck Plant full scale exercise. Negotiations with certain communities regarding some Player-Action portions of the exercise scenario are still in progress but will be finalized prior to the April 23, 1983 exercise. At that time, the finalized Exercise Controller's Manual will be provided to the Staff. Additionally, please note that our exercise objectives have been previously transmitted to the Staff and FEMA (in accordance with Reference (2)) via References (3) and (4), respectively.

The NRC Staff also indicated in Reference (1) that "the content of the exercise scenarios should be handled on a "need-to-know" basis, such that individuals who may be exercise "players" do not have access to the scenario to be used." Therefore, only a limited distribution of the attached Exercise Controller's Manual, which includes the detailed exercise scenario, is planned within the Haddam Neck Plant and corporate organizations. Likewise, we recommend that you consider making a limited distribution of the attachment within the NRC organization and also witholding the attachment from the Public Document Room until completion of the April 23, 1983 exercise.
