This letter provides the <u>N.S. SAVANNAH Port Operating Plan for</u> <u>Port of Hampton Roads, Virginia, Revised June, 1994</u> to supplement information forwarded with previous letters, and is submitted on behalf of the U.S. Maritime Administration (MARAD) and the Patriots Point Development Authority (PPDA), joint license holders under the subject possession-only license, who have requested amendment of the subject license.


