The Commission was briefed by OIA on findings contained in the investigation report concerning release of a draft IE inspection/investigation report to the Hayward Tyler Pump Co.

Mr. Cummings stated that OIA recommendations on possible Commission action would be forwarded to the Commission within several days.  
 (Subsequently, on March 30, these recommendations were forwarded to the Commission.)

Mr. DeYoung stated that a draft policy statement on conduct of investigations would be prepared by mid-May.

In response to a request by Congressman Markey, the Commission\* authorized OCA to:

1. provide the Congressman with a copy of the final OIA investigation report; (OCA/OIA) (SECY Suspense: 4/2/82)
2. include a cautionary note concerning protecting the privacy of individuals interviewed in the report;
3. inform the Congressman that a copy of the IE inspection/investigation report will be provided when completed; and
4. inform him that contents of the Region IV report are being reviewed by OIA for potential criminality and will be used as a basis for the IE report and therefore will not be released.

(Subsequently, on March 26, Congressman Markey was contacted and given the stated information.)
