SUBJECT: ORDERS CONFIRMING LICENSEE COMMITMENTS ON POST-TMI RELATED ISSUES

(GENERIC LETTERS 82-05 AND 82-10)

Haddam Neck Plant and Millstone Station, Unit No. 1

The Commission has issued the enclosed Orders confirming your commitments to implement those post-TMI related items set forth in NUREG-0737 for which the staff requested completion on or after July 1, 1981. These Orders are based on commitments contained in your letters responding to the NRC's Generic Letters 82-05 and 82-10 dated March 17, 1982 and May 5, 1982, respectively.

The Orders reference your letters and, in their Attachments, contain lists of the applicable NUREG-0737 items with your schedular commitments. As discussed in the Orders, several of the items listed in Generic Letter 82-10 will be handled outside of these Orders.

The Commission's intention when it issued NUREG-0737 was that items would be completed in accordance with the staff's recommended schedule. However, our evaluation of your proposed schedule exceptions concludes that the proposed delays are acceptable. Among other things, the Orders require implementation of these items in accordance with your proposed schedule.

Some of the items set forth in the Attachments to the Orders are subject to post implementation review and inspection. Our post implementation review and/or the development of Technical Specifications may identify alterations to your method of implementing and maintaining the requirements. Any identified alterations will be the subject of future correspondence.
