SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, announced inspection was conducted in the areas of the Physical Security Program for Power Reactors. In particular, the inspector reviewed the Effectiveness of Management Controls, Protected Area Detection Equipment, Vital Area Access Controls of Personnel and Vehicles, Testing/Maintenance/ Compensatory Measures, and Security Training/Qualification.

Results:

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In the areas inspected, violations or deviations were not identified. The licensee continues to have an effectively managed nuclear security program as evidenced by the ongoing replacement of aging protected area detection equipment. The timely repair and maintenance of other security equipment and hardware has resulted in the minimal reliance on compensatory measures. Vital area access controls during the current Unit 2 outage were appropriate. The daily performance of the security shift officers is a result of good supervision and an excellent training/qualification program. Contingency planning with the offsite law enforcement agencies was also noteworthy.

While the occurrences of unsecured vital area doors (Inspector Followup Item No. 93-19-01) continues to receive the licensee's attention, and the various corrective actions have been successful in reducing these Safeguards Events, that vulnerability remains a challenge to the site.

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
