Dear Mr. Denton:

Reference (a) transmitted the NRC's Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for the Environmental Qualification of Electrical Equipment at Zion Station, and requested our plans and schedule for equipment qualification or replacement within 90 days. On January 21, 1983, the Commission published its Final Rule on Environmental Qualification with an effective date of Februry 22, 1983. Under the new requirements of 10 CFR 50.49(g), licensees are required to identify equipment already qualified and to submit plans and schedules for qualification or replacement of the of the remaining equipment, by May 20, 1983. Commonwealth Edison will provide this information as required by May 20, 1983; therefore, we will not be providing a separate 90-day response to the SER of reference (a).
