#### ORDER

In a footnote to a May 25, 1994 motion for summary disposition on contention H, the Applicant, Louisiana Energy Services, seeks leave to file the motion. The Intervenor, Citizens Against Nuclear Trash (CANT), opposes the request asserting that the Applicant's summary disposition motion was filed months after the time set for such motions by our earlier May 7, 1992 order memorializing the prehearing conference. The Intervenor also argues that its prefiled direct testimony for the upcoming hearing is due July 1, 1994, and that responding to the Applicant's summary disposition motion at this time would divert its resources from trial preparation and prejudice its participation in the hearing. The Applicant's request for leave to file its summary disposition motion is <u>denied</u>. The Commission's regulations, 10 C.F.R. § 2.749(a), recognize the disruptive effect of eleventh hour summary disposition motions and empower us to deny such motions for that reason alone. Here, we deny the Applicant's request because its summary disposition motion has been filed beyond the time we previously established for such motions, and to require CANT to respond to the motion at this time would disrupt the Intervenor's trial preparation.

It is so ORDERED.
