

SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT COMPONENTS TO CANADA (XCOM0665)

On August 27, 1982 Cabot Corporation applied for a license to export zirconium grade seamless tubing to Canada for use at the Whiteshell Nuclear Research Establishment. The applicant has requested expeditious processing of the license application as the tubing is ready for immediate shipment and is urgently required by AECL.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
