

Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's April 28, 1994 Memorandum and Order (Discovery Related Matters), the NRC staff (Staff) hereby submits its second Status Report on the criminal investigation related to the above-captioned proceeding.

The criminal investigation regarding the alleged unauthorized use of a strontium-90 source at the Indiana Regional Cancer Center, as well as false statements made with respect to the use of that source is still ongoing. The Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Pennsylvania has informed Staff counsel that she is continuing to interview witnesses.


