By the letter dated September 3, 1982, Mr. Dale Holtzscher, Chairman of the LRG-II Working Group, provided you with position papers on six of the fifty-eight presently i'entified LRG-II issues. As you know, Illinois Power Company is a member of the LRG-II. We would like to advise you, in accordance with the practices developed by NRR and the LRG-II, that Illinois Power Company hereby incorporates five of the six position papers provided in Mr. Holtzscher's September 3, 1982 letter into the Clinton Power Station OL application.
