In a letter dated March 23, 1994, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted to the NRC an updated report on the Millstone Unit No. 1 Integrated Safety Assessment Program (ISAP). In accordance with the Program Plan identified in Amendment No. 56 for Millstone Unit No. 1, the NRC has 60 days from receipt of the letter to state whether or not the staff concurs with NNECO's positions stated in the report.

In a telephone discussion with your staff on May 24, 1994, it was agreed upon that the 60 day response letter would be delayed until after NNECO submitted a supplemental ISAP update. This supplemental ISAP update is being submitted due to the large number of topics being closed out during the recently completed refueling outage. Once the NRC receives the supplemental ISAP update, the staff will issue its review of all the ISAP topics within the 60 day window.
