Please forgive my error in not attaching these letters to my original submission

I also here support the motion of Herb Semmel to prevent from entering the record the recent depositions regarding criticality. I do not object to creating a full record, but do object to licensee's short circuit methods of submitting them. This information must pass the scrutiny of our Licensing Board before it is passed to the appeal level. I also object because I had no real opportunity to examine the witnesses, as I would have had they appeared before the Board in a local hearing. I participated extensively in the questioning of Doctors Mint, Frelewicz and Gay, and was at the pthom who elicited testimony important in this case; questions that cast doubt on the suitability of the CPLOW experimental model comes immediately to mind.

In an unrelated matter, with this mailing I am sending the promised Charlevoix Public Schools Newsletter that supports my filing before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board entitled "Remarks of John O'Neill II Concerning evacuation plans," dated March 14, 1983.
