Radiological Emergency Response Plan
Annual Review

10 CFR 50.54(t) requires that each nuclear power reactor licensee provide for an independent review of its emergency preparedness program at least every 12 months. The PGE 1981 independent review of the Trojan Radiological Emergency Plan was conducted in March 1981 by PGE coincident with the 1981 annual exercise. Within 12 months of the 1981 PGE review, the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations reviewed the Trojan Radiological Emergency Plan (December 1981), and the NRC performed the Trojan Emergency Plan Appraisal (March 1982).

The PGE 1982 independent review was initially scheduled for early April 1982, again to correspond with the annual exercise. On May 5, 1982, the NRC agreed with PGE's January 13, 1982 request to postpone the 1982 exercise until November 1982. Since 10 CFR 50.54(t) requires that the 12-month review include an evaluation of the adequacy of licensee drills and exercises, and because of the INPO and NRC reviews described above, scheduling the independent review in November 1982 is considered by PGE to be consistent with 50.54. All future Trojan exercises will be held in the October-November time period depending on schedules established with the states and counties.



PGE will promptly begin the 1982 independent review of the Trojan Radiological Emergency Plan by observing and critiquing the September 16, 1982 Trojan In-Plant/EOF/Radiological Monitoring Drill as well as auditing the other areas described in 10 CFR 50.54(t). The review will conclude following the November 18, 1982 annual exercise. On August 25, 1982 and September 8, 1982 PGE discussed this matter with Ray Fish of your office and Charles Trammell of NRR.
