This letter is in response to your April 29, 1994 letter, and Mr. Fransen's March 25, 1994 letter, regarding the possibility of dividing regulatory responsibility for uranium in situ mining and conventional milling and associated mill tailings disposal, between NRC and Wyoming under an Agreement.

Our Office of General Counsel has this issue under review to assess legislative and regulatory implications. We are also considering the policy implications of such a division of responsibility. NRC will require additional time to resolve this issue and I expect that we will complete our analyses and be in a position to respond by the end of the summer.
