Dear Mr. Giambusso:

In response to your letter of February 2, 1973, indicating acceptance of the Vogtle Nuclear Plant application, we are forwarding herewith three signed originals of the License Application, 25 copies of the License Application and Anti-Trust Information, 70 copies of the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report, and 200 copies of the Environmental Report.

Please note that as requested by members of your Staff, only 200 of the required 300 copies of the Environmental Report are forwarded at this time. The remaining 100 copies are being retained by Georgia Power Company for your use when requested.

A check in the amount of \$70,000 payable to the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission was forwarded by letter with the License Application filed on August 1, 1972.

We have noted in your letter that several items have been identified by your Staff during the mini-review which should be resolved at an early date. Emphasis is being placed on preparation of additional information.
