Subject: Qualification of Inspection, Examination and Testing  
and Audit Personnel for the Midland Project

Your letter to H. Denton dated November 2, 1981, describes your position in complying with Regulatory Guide 1.146, "Qualification of Quality Assurance Program Audit Personnel for Nuclear Power Plants" and Regulatory Guide 1.58, Revision 1, "Qualification of Nuclear Power Plant Inspection, Examination, and Testing Personnel" for the Midland project which was requested in our letter from D. Eisenhut dated May 4, 1981.

Upon re-reviewing your position on Regulatory Guide 1.58, Revision 1, we find that additional information and clarification are necessary in order to determine whether or not your qualification program for inspection, examination, and test personnel is acceptable. This matter is of particular interest to the staff since we understand that inspection activities may be under the direct responsibility of Consumers Power Company.

In this regard, please provide the following information relative to your position on Regulatory Guide 1.58, Revision 1:

1. Describe the qualification requirements of those personnel responsible for reviewing and approving inspection, examination and test procedures and of evaluating the adequacy of such procedures to accomplish the inspection, examination and test objectives. (See Position C.5)
2. Describe in more detail the extent to which the procedures and record results of written, oral, and on-the-job performance demonstration tests are documented and determined acceptable. (See Position C.10)
