## Gentlemen:

This is in response to your letter dated March 1, 1983, pertaining to a special safety inspection conducted by Mr. D. R. Gibbons on February 15, 1983.

Mr. Gibbons' inspection revealed several areas where we were in non-compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations. Corrective action has been taken and the Commission's rules, regulations and conditions of our license will be adhered to now and in the future. Following are the actions taken for the specific violations:

- The results of the appropriate analysis performed on our packaging design to determine that we are in compliance with the specifications are on file and will continue to be a permanent part of our files.
- 2. All labels on all packages have been correctly filled out with the appropriate and correct information as to (1) Contents, (2) Number of Curies, and (3) Transport Index. From now on the labels will continue to be correctly filled out as specified under 49CFR 172.403(g).

All corrective actions taken to be in full compliance with the violations listed in your letter should be considered completed by March 21, 1983. If there is any further information you require, just let me know.
