## Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter (LIC-82-373) of November 19, 1982, which requested the installation of ENS and HPN telephones .n the North Omaha Station permanent Emergency Operations Center (EOF) Your letter further requested that the telephones be installed by January 1, 1983, and that the temporary EOF telephone be maintained operational until the permanent EOF service is provided.

We have forwarded your request to our Telecommunications Branch in Washington, D.C., for action. They informed us that the ENS telephone will be installed as requested, but it will take a minimum of 90 working days to complete the installation. The HPN telephone may not be installed as the NRC is in the process of initiating the changeover of all HPN telephones to FTS service. Region IV will provide more information on this changeover in subsequent correspondence.
