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SUBJECT: EXTENDED MAINTENANCE OUTAGE

Turkey Point Unit 4 was shut down on October 10 for scheduled refueling and major maintenance, including replacement of all three steam generators. The unit is expected to be out of service for six months.

Steam generators at Turkey Point Unit 3 were replaced on schedule during an earlier outage which ended April 7, 1982.

Media interest is expected. The licensee plans to issue a news release. The NRC does not plan a news release.
