Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, I submit the following explanation and corrective actions to the notice of violation.

10 CFR 34.28 requires that radiographic exposure devices have to be inspected and maintenanced at intervals not exceeding 3 months. The records will be retained for 2 years.

These inspections and maintenance procedures were performed, but the radiographer designated to do the maintenance and inspection, failed to record this information.

Corrective Action: I have discussed this matter with the radiographer and explained the importance of keeping all required records. He has assured me that all required maintenance and inspections with proper records shall be performed.

Further Corrective Action: Maintenance and inspection shall be performed when quarterly inventory of sources are recorded. Maintenance and inspections shall be recorded on these forms also.
