NRC STAFF'S ANSWER TO MOTION OF SUNFLOWER ALLIANCE INC. TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY OF STAFF

I. INTRODUCTION

On September 28, 1982 Sunflower Alliance, Inc. (Sunflower) moved the Licensing Board for an Order granting Sunflower an additional five days to file a motion to compel discovery against the NRC Staff on the ground "that Counsel for Sunflower Alliance, Inc. has been pressed with other business and personal illness." For the reasons discussed below the Staff objects to the granting of Sunflower's motion.

II. DISCUSSION

Although Sunflower requests an additional five days to file a motion to compel discovery against the Staff, it neither identifies the discovery requests as to which it will seek to compel a Staff response nor specifies the date by which its motion will be filed if

its request is granted. In short, Sunflower seeks what appears to be unlimited approval to request at an indeterminate time to have the Board compel the Staff to respond to unidentified discovery requests of Sunflower. No basis for such an unlimited request has been provided and, for that reason alone, the motion should be denied.

III. CONCLUSION

Sunflower's motion for an extension of time to file a motion to compel discovery against the Staff must be denied.
