SHIPHENT OF RADIOGRAPHY EVICE EXCEEDING DOT LIMITS

January 26, 1982, Nuclear Energy Services of Embury, Connecticut, received a package at eir temporary job site at the Nine Mile Point : actor : near Oswego, New York. The package ntained 200 curies of iridium-192 in a radiogramy device. Surveys performed by the censee showed that a narrow beam of radiation w s measured in one direction. The exposure te that was measured was 800 mR/hr at 14 inches from the surface of the package, which dicated that radiation levels from this package exceeded the DOT limits of 200 mR/hr at ntact and 10 mR/hr at 3 feet.

e New York State Department of Labor has starts an investigation of the shipment of this ckage. The package was reported to have been slipped by air freight from Dallas, Texas.
