

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated June 1, 1977, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our May 4, 1977, inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.
