SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-461/94009(DRP)

Dear Mr. Cook:

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Messrs. P. G. Brochman, F. L. Brush, and R. A. Winter of this office on April 15 through May 16, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities associated with the April 15, 1994 overpower event at your Clinton Power Station facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities in progress, and interviews with personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. With respect to the violation, the inspection showed that actions had been taken to correct the identified violation and to prevent recurrence. Although 10 CFR 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 20 days of your receipt of this Notice, a written statement of explanation, we note that this violation had been corrected and those actions were reviewed during this inspection. Therefore, no response with respect to the violation is required.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
