Dear Mr. Keppler:

Reference (a) stated that replacement piping for Unit #1 will be completed by October 15, 1982. At the present time the piping is complete except for the tie to Unit #1 RCIC system inside the building. This work requires at least a six (6) day outage.

The work will be completed during the first available outage of six (6) days or greater. This delay should not present any safety concerns as the existing Unit #1 piping has successfully passed required tests. Commonwealth Edison decided to replace the Unit #1 piping in order to avoid the cracking problem exhibited by the Unit #2 piping.
