## Gentlemen:

On October 6, 1982, Mr. Hicks of your staff called Mr. F. W. Reimann of Region III to follow up on earlier discussions of methods which could enhance the affectiveness and the efficiency of the NRC review of your preoperational testing program. As a result of that conversation it was agreed that it is not required for Cleveland Electric Illuminating to continue sending preliminary copies of preoperational test procedures to Region III. Instead, copies of the current status of the procedures and their implementation will be forwarded to the Regional Office whenever the status is updated (at least monthly). Additionally, the most current revision of individual procedures will be forwarded to the Regional Office when requested.

The following procedures are requested for submittal to Region III at this time:

- 1. Preoperational Test for 125 vdc batteries and distribution
- 2. Preoperational Test for the Standby Liquid Control System
- 3. Containment Types A and C Leak Rate Test Procedure
- 4. Preoperational Test for Low Pressure Core Spray
- 5. Preoperational tests for Emergency Diesel Generators
- 6. Procedures which implement the QA Program requirements for the Preoperation Testing Program

Please submit the above to the attention of Mr. I. N. Jackiw. Your continued prompt attention to hhe requirements for testing program review are appreciated.
