Thank you for your letters dated March 4 and March 17, 1983, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct items which we brought to your attention in our letter dated February 4, 1983. Your corrective actions will be verified during a future inspection.

In response to your question regarding the appropriateness of the dialogue concerning proper application of the action statement for Technical Specification 3.12.2 in your March 4, 1983 letter, we feel the discussion was not inappropriate, although it did give us the impression of a denial of the violation.

It is the Regional position that a "residence" is a place in which one lives. A "resident" as used in regard to the State Park Rangers is any individual living near the site in connection with duty or work. The transitory nature of their presence is significant to the extent that it should be considered in evaluation of whether or not the radiological environmental monitoring program need be modified.
