Dear Mr. Haynes:

This letter is to cancel LER 83-12 describing a design setting error discovered in Units 1 and 2 Main Feedwater Regulating Bypass Valves.

A detailed review of the Main Feedwater Regulating Bypass Valve setting commenced upon submission of LER 83-12/1T. An error in the calculation used to determine the flow through the Main Feedwater Regulating Bypass Valves was discovered during this review. The original Main Feedwater Regulating Bypass Valve settings would allow 5% feed flow, which is within the assumed flow for a Main Steam Line Break accident. Consequently, an LER is not warranted.
