SUBJECT: MANAGEMENT MEETING AT ANACONDA-ERICSSON, INC., WIRE AND CABLE DIVISION, MARCH 8, 1983

An initial management meeting was conducted at Anaconda-Ericsson, Inc., Wire and Cable Division (AE/W&CD), Malvern, Pennsylvania. The purpose of the presentation, given to AE/W&CD management personnel, was to describe and explain the NRC Equipment Qualification Program. The presentation included the NRC and Region IV organizations, bases for inspection, history of the EQ program, and status of proposed rules being developed and in the adoption process. In addition, the format, content, dissemination, and publication of NRC inspection reports were discussed in detail.

The meeting then turned to general discussions and questions/answers. The meeting was very constructive because AE/W&CD and NRC management now better understand the respective organization's responsibilities, organizational structure and operations.

At the conclusion of the meeting, Mr. Paul Cardello, Vice President, said that AE/W&CD would review equipment qualification requirements as discussed and decide if they would perform qualification testing in-house or subcontract testing as done in the past. He said he would notify Region IV within 2-3 weeks of their decision. If AE/W&CD were going to test in-house, they would establish quality assurance controls on their qualification testing either by modification of their existing QA program or establishment of a

He said that once the procedures are implemented then AE/W&CD would be ready for an equipment qualification inspection.
