Dear Mr. Council:

RE: Resolution of the Seismic Qualification of Auxiliary Feedwater System issued for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2.

By letters dated July 24, 1981 and June 4, 1982 you responded to our multi-plant request letter dated October 21, 1980 regarding seismic qualification of the auxiliary feedwater system (AFWS). The objective of this issue is to increase the capability of those plants without seismically qualified AFWS to withstand the postulated Safe Shutdown Earthquake.

Enclosed is our Safety Evaluation with the attached Technical Evaluation Report prepared by our consultant, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory.

Based on our review we conclude that the AFWS at Millstone 2 is able to perform its designed safety-related function after a Safe Shutdown Earthquake to assure safe shutdown of the plant.

Accordingly, we consider this issue resolved for Millstone Unit No. 2.
