In accordance with your application dated June 4, 1982, and pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70, Materials License No. SNM-1227 is hereby amended to authorize sewer discharge of process liquids and to change environmental monitoring requirements. Accordingly:

1. Condition 9 is amended to include the date of June 4.
2. Conditions 15 and 16 are deleted.
3. Condition 17 is revised to read:

Notwithstanding the statements and representations in Section 3 of the application forwarded by letter dated June 4, 1982, water samples from the test wells listed in Table 3.7 of the Environmental Impact Appraisal issued by the Commission in August 1981 shall be analyzed monthly for uranium or gross alpha, fluoride, nitrate, ammonia, sulfate, and pH instead of conductivity.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

The wording change in Condition 17 was discussed, and agreed to, by your Mr. Malody and Mr. Bidinger of my staff.
