UNIT 2


A public meeting was convened by the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) at 7:00 P. m. on Thursday, April 14, 1994, in Ballrooms A and B of the Harrisburg, Hotel, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the recent entry of the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 2 (TMI-2) into long term storage, termed Post Defueling Monitored Storage (PDMS), by the licensee, General Public Utilities Nuclear Corporation (GPUN). Several additional issues pertaining to TMI-2 were also discussed at the meeting, including contamination of the cork seam in the TMI-2 auxiliary building, remaining NRC staff activities, funding for the ultimate decommissioning of TMI-2, and issuance of a recent draft NRC policy statement on the early use of decommissioning funds.

Four members of the former TMI-2 Advisory Panel for the Decontamination of TMI-2 were present, A. Morris, J. Luetzelschwab, A. Trunk, and N. Wald. NRC employees present were, M. Masnik, L. Thonus, R. Dudley, M. Webb, M. Evans and J. Rogge. D. Westhall, a foreign assignee at the NRC from Australia was also present at the meeting.

Enclosure 1 is a copy of the agenda for the April 14, 1994 meeting.

Enclosure 2 is a copy of the transcript of the meeting which identifies members of the former TMI-2 Advisory Panel, GPUN speakers, and members of the public that spoke at the meeting. It also includes copies of the handouts and overhead projections provided by the speakers during the meeting.

The meeting was attended by approximately 6 members of the public and approximately 3 members of the local print media. The level of public participation can be found in Enclosure 2.
