Enclosed is a letter from Transnuclear regarding their request of March 29, 1983 to amend export license XSNMO1982 to authorize the export of Australianorigin material.

The actual quantity of material scheduled for export in May 1983 is as follows:

8,391 Kgs uranium, under DOE contract UES/EU/20, is of Australian origin

10,277 Kgs uranium, under DOE contract 4724-DUE, is of U.S. origin
