RE: Molycorp's, Washington Facility Decommission


Dear Mr. Austin:

I represent Greg Wood and other citizens and residents of Washington County who are members of the Pennsylvania Environmental Defense Foundation and who are concerned with the radiation levels along Chartiers Creek adjacent to the Molycorp, Inc. facility in Washington, Pennsylvania.

I have read your letter of July 30, 1993. I am writing to request a copy of Molycorp's Site Characterization Plan as described on page two of your letter and a copy of the Site Decommissioning Plan where necessary.

My clients have observed no activity in the Molycorp plant area to clean up the site as they had anticipated would happen. It is evident, however, that much of the personnel from Molycorp have left the site. There are also rumors that Molycorp no longer owns or controls the site. Please confirm or correct these observations.

I look forward to a prompt response to our concerns.
