The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. During the inspection of License No. 12-02530-03, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix.
